Labour and skills are constraining regional economic growth

Australia's regions rebounded quickly from the 2020 COVID restrictions, and have seen high rates of growth in economic output and jobs. Good growing conditions in most of Australia's rural areas through 2020 and 2021 are leading to high levels of confidence and consequential high levels of demand for workers - increasingly skilled workers. But job vacancy growth is outstripping employment in signs of a very tight regional labour market, workers. with regional employers competing against each other for scarce Labour shortages are emerging as a constraint on regional economic growth, exacerbated by current housing shortages. Skills gaps are also emerging, as the agriculture industry joins many others in seeing its labour force becoming more highly skilled and qualified. The seminar will explore options for lifting the skills base of the regional labour force, and facilitating the movement of skilled workers into Australia's regions.
