## **Mini-Symposia and Thematic Sessions – Call for Submissions**

The Local Organising Committee for the 2023 AARES Conference welcomes submissions for Mini-Symposia (MS) and Thematic Sessions (TS), highlighting the latest research and policy applications in agricultural, environmental, resource, ecological, energy, fisheries, food, agribusiness, and development economics. They should be designed to attract new members and/or conference day registrations (private/industry/government) and provide topics of interest for current AARES members.

The MS and TS normally involve 3–4 expert presentations and discussions on a particular topic in a 90-minute session. They will be scheduled during the Conference between the 8–10<sup>th</sup> of February 2023.

### **Submissions**

An organiser should make submissions for Mini-Symposia or Thematic Sessions. The proposals should include:

- Title of the symposium/session
- A brief (100-200 words) description of the topic and its significance
- Names and affiliations of authors of individual presentations within the MS/TS
- Names and affiliations of discussants.

Organisers of MT/TS are encouraged to:

- include colleagues from government, industry or other disciplines as speakers and participants
- if appropriate, develop a series of papers that can become a special section or special issue in the Australian Journal of Agricultural and Resource Economics
- promote their event to help raise the profile of the Conference and the Society.
