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## **Changes to AARES Legal Status**

As members should now be aware, the Federal Council of AARES initiated the process of changing the legal status of our Society to a Company Limited by Guarantee, to be registered as a Charity, and to be endorsed as an Income-Tax Exempt Company. This is, in part, as a result of the 2016 Strategic Planning.

We have retained a specialist legal firm to assist us with this process.

At the time of writing, the Society has:

- Been renamed the Australasian Agricultural and Resource Economics Society Limited
- Been approved by ASIC as a Company Limited by Guarantee
- Been granted an ABN
- Applied to the ACNC for registration as a Charity

Once this is complete, AARES will apply to the ATO for endorsement as an Income-Tax Exempt Company. We anticipate that this will be achieved by the time of the AGM on 8 February 2018.

A separate notice of the AGM (including the agenda) is included on page 4 of this edition of News & Views.

As part of this process, we have upgraded the Constitution and there are some final (minor) amendments to the Constitution that will be voted on as Special Resolutions at the AGM.

#### **AARES Webinars**

AARES recommenced its webinar program after a long break, with a joint AARES-NZARES webinar on the economics of Animal Welfare. Kathryn Bicknell (Senior Lecturer in Economics at Lincoln University, New Zealand) spoke on the topic of 'The distributional implications of farm animal welfare policy'.

Kathryn took the audience through the basics of farm animal welfare mechanisms and addressed some of the second round responses to farm welfare controls, such as product substitution from imports of product produced without these controls, and effects on consumer welfare from price impacts.

There were 22 people who registered for the webinar and, of these, 15 people attended during the live broadcast. Another two people have viewed the recorded webinar since then. Overall, the feedback for the webinar has been very positive; all

nine survey respondents rated the webinar four or five out of five.
